

Mini-Grants for Teachers

Before You Begin

Deadlines for Applications: June 15

Applications must be submitted by midnight. Applications will be accepted until the following business day at midnight if the due date falls on a weekend or holiday. Only complete applications will be considered for funding.

How Does It Work?

Through a straightforward application process, K-12 teachers can apply for grant funding to provide enriching academic experiences in their classrooms—typical grant awards range from \$500 - \$1,500.

The teacher mini-grant application should focus on a creative project in an academic subject. The academic project should be used to encourage students to use innovative methods to learn important concepts and skills. Mini-Grants enable the purchase of special materials and resources for the classroom. They are intended to support projects not provided for within school budgets or other means.

Who Can Apply?

All South Plains region K-12 teachers are encouraged to apply. **(Pre-K classrooms are not eligible to apply.)** Eligibility includes public schools and non-public schools recognized by the Texas Private School Accreditation Commission (TEPSAC) and the Commissioner of Education. No more than one grant will be awarded per teacher per year.

Funding Priorities:

A committee consisting of educators, community volunteers, donors, and Community Foundation of West Texas Board and staff reviews applications. Applications will be judged on the following criteria:

- Impact: Potential to improve student achievement; potential for continuation and replication; potential to enhance instructional skills
- Innovation: Innovative approach making learning memorable; enhance academic objective within curriculum context
- Planning: Clear plan for project implementation; teacher capability; cost-effectiveness and realistic budget;
- Existing Resources: Grant funding will not supplant existing funding - the project cannot be achieved with existing school budget

Excluded Projects:

Mini-grant applications will not be considered for the renovation of facilities, religious activities or teachings, non-academic projects, trips out of this region, or tuition for special classes.

Reporting:

All grantees are required to submit a Final Report within one year of the grant award. A Final Report link for each grant awarded will be available on your account page. Future grant awards are conditioned upon the receipt of complete reporting. In some cases, it may be appropriate to submit a Progress Report. If this is the case, you will be notified by Foundation staff, and a link will be made available on your account page.
