

The Foundation began serving our region in 1981. Four decades later, our community has seen over \$36M of philanthropic impact. Almost half (\$17M) has been granted in the last five years. We granted \$3.6M in 2021 alone. The Foundation has given out 10,452 grants since inception and gave 773 of those grants in 2021.

We are honored to serve and work hard to increase our role in the community. In the last eight quarters, we transitioned the Mental Health Initiative to the next level of community service, assisted in the completion of the Gateway-Tornado Memorial LNB Park, and partnered on the COVID-19 Response Fund. Each was a major undertaking. Our Board and staff have a proven track record of excellence and serving our community in philanthropy.

The prudent investment of assets is central to the Foundation's responsibilities. Our reputation and capacity for serving the community is directly tied to our ability to conserve capital and secure the best possible return. Endowment funds exist to provide perpetual resources for charitable purposes. As a result, investment decisions are made more conservatively with perpetuity in mind. To meet our investment objectives, the Foundation follows a strategy focusing on long-term total return. Investments are diversified to avoid any single security or class of securities having a disproportionate impact on the total portfolio.

The Power of Endowment

There is no better way to serve your community than to give back to your community. The Foundation offers several charitable fund types that can be tailored to your needs and wishes.

Fund Types

| Community Fund | Allow the Foundation to identify needs and opportunities in the community and target your dollars where they can be most effective through competitive grants. |
|------------------------|--|
| Field of Interest Fund | You decide the general purpose of the fund; such as education, arts, aging, children and youth, animal welfare or health, and the Foundation funds projects that are effectively furthering your charitable interest through competitive grants. |
| Designated Fund | Specify particular charitable projects or organizations to receive grants from your endowed fund. |
| Donor Advised Fund | Annually recommend organizations or causes you wish to support or our staff can work with you to identify charitable organizations addressing issues of importance to you. You recommend grants to charities you wish to support. The Foundation ensures the charitable status of beneficiaries and provides grantmaking, oversight and administrative support. |
| Scholarship Fund | Work with the Foundation to create the guidelines for students who can receive assistance from the fund. For example, selection may be based on high school or college attended, merit, need, or field of study. |
| Agency Endowment | A nonprofit agency can establish a fund for the benefit of that agency. The Foundation regularly distributes grants back to the agency for purposes chosen by the agency. |

Endowment

Endowment funds carry an inherent power to provide for community needs in perpetuity through continued growth.


Non-Endowed

Monies are received by the Foundation and distributed with little or no dollars remaining with the Foundation.

Acorn

A starter endowed fund created with \$1,000 or more that allows the donor up to 5 years to reach the required fund minimum.

Endowment Options

The Community Foundation of West Texas can accept a variety of gifts from donors as well as support gift planning to maximize the impact to the donor and charity.

When to Give

Take advantage of a number of gift planning tools offered. The experienced staff at the Community Foundation of West Texas will work with you and your advisor to include a charitable gift from your family, business or estate plan.

Bequest

A provision is made in a will or trust to gift a portion if not all of an estate to establish or add to a charitable fund.

Termination of Private Foundation

A private foundation can be converted to a fund at CFWT and the compliance and due diligence will be handled for you.

Charitable Gift Annuity

Make a tax-deductible gift now in exchange for a lifetime income stream with the remainder going to a charitable fund at a later date.

Charitable Remainder Trust

Use this tax strategy to minimize tax consequences on highly appreciated assets while still receiving an income stream for life or a stated period of time with the principal going to a charitable fund at the CFWT.

Charitable Lead Trust

This can be used to generate a charitable deduction upon receiving a windfall or used as an estate planning tool to minimize estate taxes. After the trust term ends, the remainder returns to either the donor or family, depending on the type of trust.

What to Give

Nearly any asset can be converted into cash for charitable purposes, often with tax saving benefits. Whether you are planning your estate, succession or business sale, or year-end gifting strategies, we can assist you in limiting your tax liability relating to capital gains.

Cash Gifts

Credit Cards

Credit card giving can be done through cfwtx.org/give-now. Give one time, or set up recurring gifts.

IRA Charitable Rollover

Gift up to \$100,000 from your individual retirement account and offset your required minimum distribution.

Real Estate

Take advantage of a variety of giving opportunities by donating land, vacation homes, commercial properties and primary residences.

Stocks, Bonds and Mutual Funds

Avoid paying capital gains tax on the sale of appreciated stock, bonds and mutual funds.

Business-Related Assets

Gifting a portion of all of a privately held C-Corp, S-Corp, LLC or limited partnership can be an efficient tax planning option in the event of a liquidity event.

Other Assets

Donate your copyrights, royalties, patents and oil and gas interests to the Community Foundation of West Texas and receive an income tax deduction for the full fair market value of the interest.

Wills & Trusts

Leave a percentage or specific dollar amount provision in your will or trust, making the Community Foundation of West Texas as a beneficiary.

Retirement Plan Assets

The most efficient gift is naming the Community Foundation of West Texas as a partial or outright beneficiary of your retirement plan, including IRAs, 401(k)s, 403(b)s and other qualified plans.

Life Insurance

Gift a fully funded policy during your lifetime or name the Community Foundation of West Texas as a beneficiary.

Endowed Funds

Green Family

Chester and Ada Ruth Green were Lubbock residents since 1956. Chester earned a degree in Civil Engineering from Texas Tech University and was a principal in a local consulting engineering firm until 1991 when he retired. The College of Engineering honored him as a Distinguished Engineer in 1989. Ada Ruth was a Girl Scout leader, Sunday School teacher, homemaker, and mother to two daughters. Both Chester and Ada Ruth were active in and supported many local organizations.

After providing inheritances for their children and grandchildren, the couple wanted to do something to help the community that meant so much to them. After seeking counsel, both their attorney and banker suggested they establish an endowment fund with the Community Foundation of West Texas. Once learning more about the Foundation, the Greens realized that it was the partnership they had been seeking and started their fund in

1992. Chester and Ada Ruth increased the funding of their endowmen't each year and made provisions in their wills to leave additional funds.

The Greens loved seeing the wide variety of worthy causes assisted by grants from their fund. It was important to Chester and Ada Ruth that they create something that would continue to support local organizations long after they passed, and that is just what their fund has done. The Greens created a legacy that will impact many lives for years to come.

Transforming Lives in the Community

Literacy Lubbock

Literacy Lubbock funded its mail-out student retention project and will start offering Spanish GED test tutoring in 2022 through a community grant from CFWT. The organization wrote: "Student retention is difficult for our adult learners because work, family, and transportation issues often prevent them from attending class. Additionally, our GED program is not equipped to prepare Spanish speakers with limited English skills to take the GED test."

To increase student retention, Literacy Lubbock plans to send out postcards to students who signed up for programs and either did not show up or stopped attending them. The organization will acquire Spanish GED prep software by purchasing logins for the Spanish version of the program Literacy Lubbock already uses. Offering this software, the nonprofit says, "will allow us to help Spanish speakers take the Spanish GED test and obtain better-paying jobs and educational opportunities." Literacy Lubbock reports that the funding will immediately affect 255 people and potentially many more as the nonprofit implements this new strategy and program.



Investing in Our Future Association of Texas Leaders for Education



The 2021 Association of Texas Leaders for Education Scholarship recipient is Frenship High School alumnus Scout Sonnenberg. Since graduating, Scout has started taking classes at Texas Tech University, working toward a degree in Studio Art with an emphasis in painting and a minor in Psychology. After college, Scout plans to pursue a career in Art Therapy.

Scout was born blind and was later diagnosed with a rare genetic anomaly similar to Rieger's Syndrome and, as a result, has malignant glaucoma. She has had 42 eye surgeries to date -- from these surgeries, she has regained some of her sight but says she cannot rely on her vision due to malformations in her eye and the progression of her glaucoma. On top of navigating legal blindness, Scout also had part of her foot amputated after two failed surgeries. Having been a hospital patient many times in her life, Scout says she wants to "work with a team of traditional/expressive therapists to help children receiving treatments in hospitals as an Art Therapist."

Scout does not let her disabilities get in her way and mentors other blind and visually impaired students. Scout writes, "I want to hear their stories and give them a fresh means of expression that is generally overlooked when you cannot see. I know it is my calling to pave the way for the little ones coming up behind me; to reach back and give them some hope."
