Each year we strive to honor you, your fund, and your philanthropic goals. Striving to build and improve tomorrow begins with improving our methodologies today. Each department at Community Foundation of West Texas, program and grants, development, marketing, and accounting have generated a multitude of successes in the 2017 calendar year.

The Development Department, led by Vice President Michelle Tosi-Stephens has created 22 new funds. The leadership and direction has placed you, the donor, and the recipient, our non-profits, churches, and schools in the captain's chair of the best service in the business. Michelle is working closely with Kayla Boyett, our Marketing Coordinator to provide communication to enhance decisions, making your plans easier and convenient. She is ensuring the smallest to the largest gift are treated with the same care and dedication.

The Program department, led by Vice President Tami Swoboda is managing each of our 284 funds. From the very first fund created in 1982 to the funds created in 2017, every dollar continues its quest, to the organizations they were created to support. The assets in management, over \$42 million, are optimized for the best return for each grant and scholarship recipient. Director of Programs and Grants, Denise Oviedo, is compassionate, dedicated, and especially focused on our community grants. In 2017, Community Foundation of West Texas, through the 284 funds, grants and scholarships, awarded \$2,058,659.57; another great year above 2 million dollars.

The accounting department, led by Carla Stricklin, is creating new and improving current methodologies. Each is important while tracking the funds, grants, scholarships, and expenditures. Over the years I've witnessed a plethora of knowledgeable and task oriented accountants as they track and balance organizations. 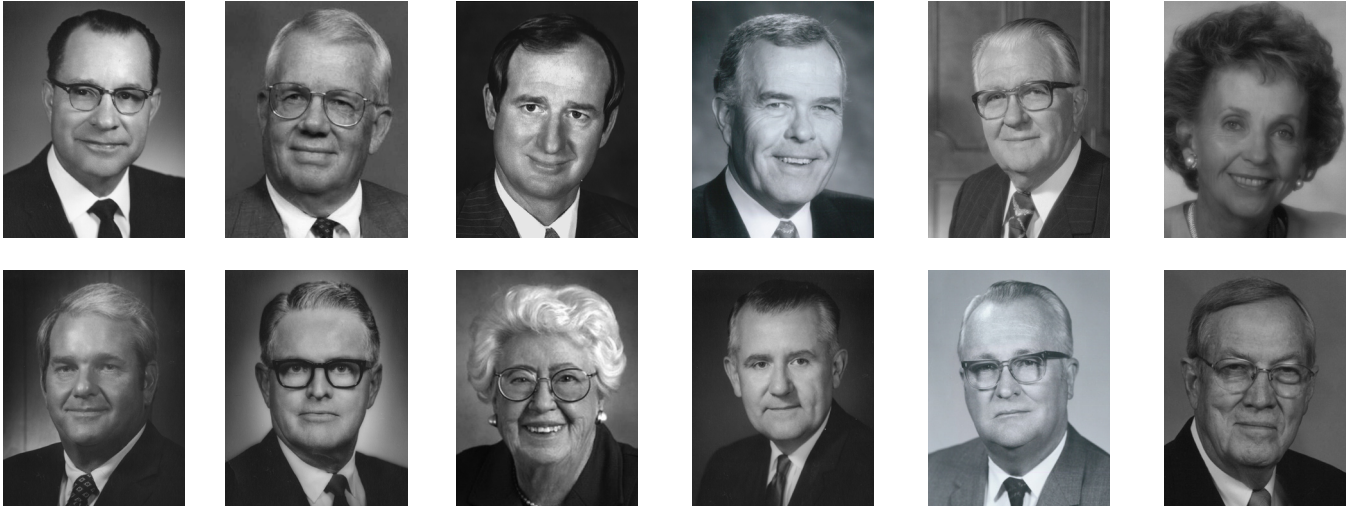

## Investment Management

The prudent investment of assets is central to the Community Foundation’s responsibilities. Our reputation and capacity for serving the community is directly tied to our ability to conserve capital and secure the best possible return. Endowment funds exist to provide perpetual resources for charitable purposes. As a result, investment decisions are made more conservatively than those for personal investments. To meet our investment objectives, the Community Foundation follows a strategy focusing on long-term total return. Investments are diversified to avoid any single security or class of securities having a disproportionate impact on the total portfolio.

Choose the type of fund you wish to set up.

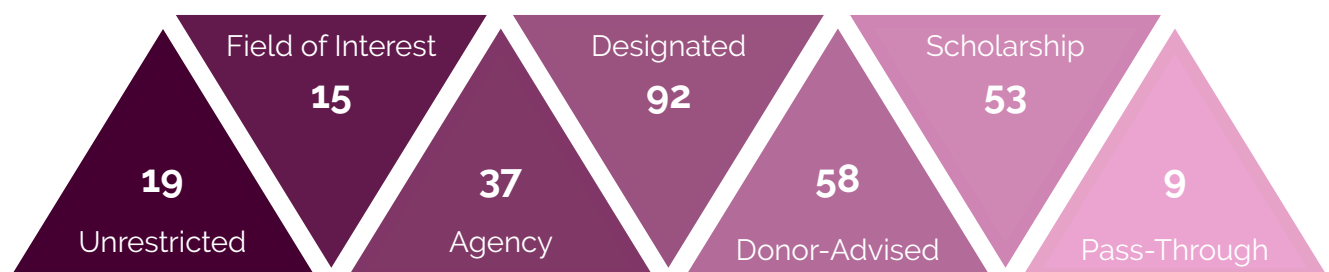

| <b>Field-of-Interest Fund</b> | You decide the general purpose of the fund, such as education, arts, aging, children and youth, animal welfare or health, and the Community Foundation of West Texas identifies projects that are effectively accomplishing that goal through competitive grants.  |
| <b>Designated Fund</b>        | Specify particular charitable projects or organizations to receive the income from your endowed fund.  |
| <b>Donor-Advised Fund</b>     | Recommend organizations or causes you wish to support or our staff can work with you to identify charitable organizations addressing issues of importance to you. You recommend grants to charities you wish to support. The Community Foundation of West Texas ensures the charitable status of beneficiaries and provides additional grantmaking and administrative support. |
| <b>Scholarship Fund</b>       | Work with the Community Foundation of West Texas to create the guidelines for students who can receive assistance from the fund. For example, these may be based on high school or college attended, merit, need, or field of study.   |
| <b>Agency Endowment</b>       | A nonprofit agency can establish a fund for the benefit of their agency. The Community Foundation of West Texas regularly distributes grants back to the agency for purposes chosen by the agency.   |

## Faces of Philanthropy

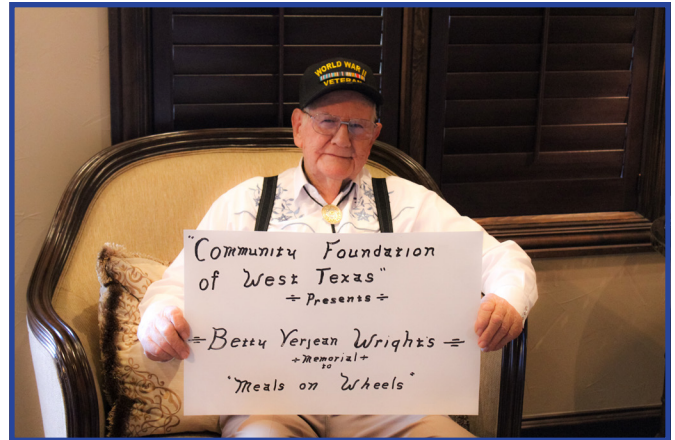

The Slaton Area Endowment is the newest member of the Community Foundation's affiliates. The endowment has over \$340,000 and supports funds for 4 designated organizations. ## Grants: Investing in the Community

At the Community Foundation of West Texas we believe that every grant is an investment in the communities we serve. We are committed to making a meaningful difference with a focus on promoting thriving communities, encouraging education at all ages, enriching lives through the arts, and assuring basic needs and self-sufficiency are met for families in the South Plains. Below are just a few of the stories of our grants and scholarship recipients.

### Promoting the Arts in the Community

*Louise Hopkins Underwood Center for the Arts*



The Louise Hopkins Underwood Center for the arts, commonly known as LHUCA, was established in 1997 to provide a home for the arts in the South Plains.

In 2017, LHUCA received a grant from the Community Foundation of West Texas to promote their latest project, the Healing Arts Outreach Program. The program began as a partnership between LHUCA, StarCare Speciality Health System and Covenant Community Health Outreach Services. The program's goal is to expand the healing arts programming for underserved people with low to moderate incomes. The project offered courses that were conducted from October 2017 to July 2018, with publications from the participants to be sent to publish in Fall 2018.

LHUCA also hopes to share their experience with other organizations who may be interested in beginning an Arts-in-Healthcare program in their community.

### Taking Care of Citizens in the Community

*Llano Estacado Silver Star Board*

The Llano Estacado Silver Star Board is an organization whose sole purpose is to provide resources to those who are in the Adult Protective Services system. These clients include elderly persons and disabled adults who have been neglected, abused or exploited.



The Llano Estacado Silver Star Board received a grant from the Community Foundation in 2017 to alleviate the need for heating and air conditioning for those in the Adult Protective Services program. With this grant, the Llano Estacado Silver Star Board was able to purchase air conditioners and heaters for their clients to make them

more comfortable in the winter and in the summer when harsh weather hits the South Plains.

### Investing in Our Future

*Don & Sybil Harrington Scholarship Recipient - Raja Rajcic*

Raja is a sophomore, studying Computer Science and Electrical Engineering at Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He's on MIT's varsity track and field team, where his event is pole vaulting. Raja is also a member of several student organizations at MIT. He's a counselor for Camp Kesem, a camp for children whose parents have or have had cancer. He is a member of the MIT chapter of Design for America (DFA), which tackles social challenges through design innovation, and he is a member of Technique, a photography club.



In addition to his studies and school activities, Raja also had a summer internship with EMBR Labs in Boston, where he was an intern specializing in research and development on the latest multi-sensory wearable technology. Raja has continued working at EMBR Labs throughout the school year.

Thanks to the Don & Sybil Harrington Scholarship, Raja was able to be exposed to a new environment with many amazing and driven people, dedicated to learning and helping others, without the added financial stress of college. Upon graduation, Raja wishes to either be employed at a technology company, or to pursue graduate school, focusing on computer science.
