Investment Management

The prudent investment of assets is central to the Community Foundation's responsibilities. Our reputation and capacity for serving the community is directly tied to our ability to conserve capital and secure the best possible return. Endowment funds exist to provide perpetual resources for charitable purposes. As a result, investment decisions are made more conservatively than those for personal investments. To meet our investment objectives, the Community Foundation follows a strategy focusing on long-term total return. Investments are diversified to avoid any single security or class of securities having a disproportionate impact on the total portfolio.

The Power of Endowment

There is no better way to serve your community than to give back to your community. The Community Foundation of West Texas offers several different types of charitable funds that can be set up according your needs and wishes. We want to help you support the causes close to your heart.

Fund Types

Choose the type of fund you wish to set up.

Community Fund

Allow the Community Foundation of West Texas to identify needs and opportunities in the community and target your dollars where they can be most effective through competitive grants.

Field-of-Interest Fund

You decide the general purpose of the fund, such as education, arts, aging, children and youth, animal welfare or health, and the Community Foundation of West Texas identifies projects that are effectively accomplishing that goal through competitive grants.

Designated Fund

Specify particular charitable projects or organizations to receive the income from your endowed fund.

Donor-Advised Fund

Recommend organizations or causes you wish to support or our staff can work with you to identify charitable organizations addressing issues of importance to you. You recommend grants to charities you wish to support. The Community Foundation of West Texas ensures the charitable status of beneficiaries and provides additional grantmaking and administrative support.

Scholarship Fund

Work with the Community Foundation of West Texas to create the guidelines for students who can receive assistance from the fund. For example, these may be based on high school or college attended, merit, need, or field of study.

Agency Endowment

A nonprofit agency can establish a fund for the benefit of their agency. The Community Foundation of West Texas regularly distributes grants back to the agency for purposes chosen by the agency.

Endowment

Endowment funds carry an inherent power to provide for community needs in perpetuity through continued growth.


Non-Endowed (Limited-Term)

Monies are received by the Foundation and distributed with little or no dollars remaining with the Foundation.

Acorn

A starter fund created with \$1,000 or more that allows the donor up to 5 years to reach the required fund minimum.

Grants: Investing in the Community

Below are just a few of the stories of our grants and scholarship recipients.

Promoting the Arts in the CommunityLouise Hopkins Underwood Center for the Arts



The Louise Hopkins Underwood Center for the arts, commonly known as LHUCA, was established in 1997 to provide a home for the arts in the South Plains.

In 2017, LHUCA received a grant from the Community Foundation of West Texas to promote their latest project, the Healing Arts Outreach Program. The program began as a

partnership between LHUCA, StarCare Speciality
Health System and Covenant Community Health
Outreach Services. The program's goal is to expand the
healing arts programming for underserved people with
low to moderate incomes. The project offered courses
that were conducted from October 2017 to July 2018,
with publications from the participants to be sent to
publish in Fall 2018.

LHUCA also hopes to share their experience with other organizations who may be interested in beginning an Arts-in-Healthcare program in their community.

Taking Care of Citizens in the Community Llano Estacado Silver Star Board

The Llano Estacado Silver Star Board is an organization whose sole purpose is to provide resources to those who are in the Adult Protective Services system. These clients include elderly persons and disabled adults who have been neglected, abused or exploited.



The Llano Estacado Silver Star Board received a grant from the Community Foundation in 2017 to alleviate the need for heating and air conditioning for those in the Adult Protective Services program. With this grant, the Llano Estacado Silver Star Board was able to purchase air conditioners and heaters for their clients to make them

more comfortable in the winter and in the summer when harsh weather hits the South Plains.
